The next **Recreation Commission Meeting** is scheduled for **Tuesday, November 6th at 6pm** at the Parks and Recreation Department Office in the George B. White Building.

Sit with Santa, Fireman's Parade and Holiday Lighting will take place on Sunday, November 27th from 2pm to 4pm @ Deerfield Town Hall. Children will sit with Santa while families enjoy carols, hot cocoa, home baked goodies and other Holiday activities. At 4pm we will unveil our Holiday lights at the Gazebo Field. The Fireman's Parade will then make its way through the Village at 4pm. The Parade route begins at the Deerfield Penguin Mart and ends on Church Street. The events are free of charge but donated baked goods are appreciated.

Holiday Lighting Extravaganza is a contest that is free to enter and there will be prizes for the winners in three separate categories. Categories will include: Most Spectacular, Most Creative and Simply Elegant. The deadline to enter is Friday, December 9th. All homes and businesses should be ready to display by Saturday, December 17th. The judging will take place on Sunday, December 18th.

Winter Holiday Camp will be on December 27th through December 30th and is open to grades K through 6. Camp will take place from 8am to 6pm at the George B. White Building. Cost of the camp is \$25 per day and you may sign up for as many or as few days as you like. The final registration deadline is Friday, December 20th.

Turkey Bowl II is a day of Flag Football on Sunday November 20th at Hartford Brook Field. Two Divisions: Adult Open Division 18+ and 45+ divisions. Must register as a team of 6-8 players (6 on field at once). COST IS FREE. Turkey Bowl Trophies will be awarded to each championship team. Registration deadline is Monday November 14th.

Holiday Shopping Trip will be on Friday December 9th. On the shopping agenda will be Fox Run Mall, Fox Run Crossing, Christmas Tree Shop and the Maine Kittery Outlets. TRIP IS FREE! You will be on your own for lunch at the Fox Run Mall. Van will be leaving from the George B. White Building at 9am then picking up at the Sherburne Woods Apartments (if necessary) and returning by 4pm.

Adult Pick-Up Basketball takes place every Tuesday evening at the Deerfield Community School Gymnasium. The program runs from 7:30-9:00 PM and the cost is \$2 per evening (\$4 for non-residents) or \$25 for the season (\$40 for non-residents). Season runs till March. There will be no basketball during school vacation weeks, or when school is cancelled or dismissed early for bad weather, or when there is a school function.

Grades 5, 4, and 3 Dance and Karaoke Party will be on Friday, November 18th and Friday December 16th from 6:30-8:30pm at the George B. White Building "Studio 59." Dance is open to Deerfield residents. Cost is \$5 per person. Parents are welcome to stay or leave.

Cookie Clubhouse is open to pre-school aged children and toddlers. We meet Mondays beginning November 21st from 9:30-10:30am at Deerfield Town Hall. Cost is free! Supply donations are accepted.

Yoga with Nancy is held on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 6-7pm at the Deerfield Town Hall on Church Street. Cost is \$60 for six weeks or \$10 per drop-in. Reduce stress and strengthen the body and mind. Mats provided.
