

Supervisor's of Checklist minutes for October 29, 2016

Meeting called to order at 10:30 AM for the registration of any new voters as called for by law. Present were Gloria Riel and Harriet Cady as Diana Allard was excused for a business meeting. There were 55 new voters as registered with the Town Clerk to be entered into the data base.

Gloria Riel and Harriet noted upon entering the state program that 18 voters needed to be removed as having moved from Deerfield and registered in other towns.

Gloria and Harriet proceeded to enter the persons who had filled out forms with the town clerk, there were 55 new registrations.

Harriet opened a letter from Patricia Giaquinta of 72A Ridge Road, Deerfield who was concerned that they had received a 30 day letter removing her Dad from the checklist as he had died and they couldn't understand why he was still on the checklist. Harriet called Ms. Giaquinto and explained that he had died at the Brentwood Nursing Home and therefore was recorded in Brentwood but having seen his death for Deerfield needed to confirm that Rudolph Gianquinto was indeed the Joseph Giaquinto on the checklist. Patricia confirmed her Dad usually went by his middle name and so he was confirmed as legally removed from Deerfield's voting checklist.

The Supervisors will next meet On Thursday, November 4th at 2 PM to check a petition for accurate signatures and print checklists to be posted.
